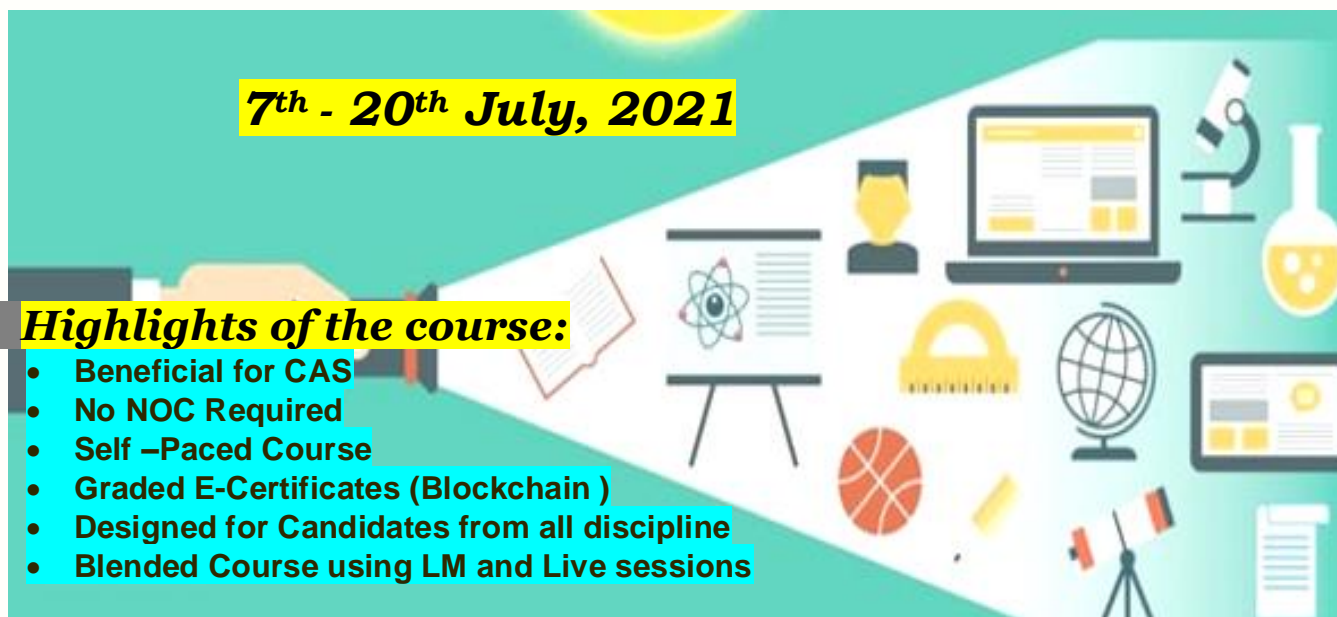

NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY 2020

*The National Education Policy aims to reorient the education system towards meeting the needs of the 21st century by achieving the twin objectives of inclusion and excellence. It sets the vision of developing an equitable and vibrant knowledge society by providing quality education to all, as stated by the **President of India, Shri Ram Nath Kovind**. The third NEP - National Education Policy 2020 is the first education policy of the 21st century and aims to address the many growing developmental imperatives of our country. This Policy proposes the revision and revamping of all aspects of the education structure.*

*A novel feature of NEP, is that it would also introduce the system of **Academic Bank of Credits**. With approval of this policy India is all set to witness a much needed reformation in education, one that focuses on the essentials of learning in the present, while preparing students for a future they get to shape. NEP aims to assign **Blended learning** an important role claiming that it would provide more flexibility and choice to the learners for developing 21st century skills, encourage cognition and creativity. With its multidisciplinary approach, students will have the opportunities to innovate and adapt, allowing them to swiftly move between different interests and fields, enabling constant up-gradation of skills. The new policy ensures that the knowledge and opportunities students receive here, are on par with global standards.*

CONCEPT NOTE

*New Education Policy 2020 (NEP-2020) is promulgated by the Government of India in July 2020 to replace the previous National Policies on Education in order to bring changes in Indian Education System. This Online Refresher Course is diligently planned around developing the foundation knowledge needed about the new concept introduced through New Education Policy 2020. **The Course content is designed to disseminate knowledge about the important aspects of the NEP – Academic Bank Credit (ABC) Scheme in Higher Education and Blended learning.***

*“**Academic Bank of Credits (ABC)**” is an academic service mechanism as a digital/virtual/online entity established and managed by MOE/UGC to facilitate students to become its academic account holders and paving the way for seamless student mobility. between*

or within degree-granting Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) through a formal system of credit recognition, credit accumulation, credit transfers and credit redemption to promote distributed and flexible teaching-learning.;

Blended learning is not a mere mix of online and face-to-face mode, but it refers to a well-planned combination of meaningful activities in both the modes. Given the emergence of digital technologies and the emerging importance of leveraging technology for teaching-learning at all levels from school to higher education, the NEP recommends for use of blended models of learning. Blended learning shifts the teacher's role from knowledge provider to coach and mentor. The area of assessment and evaluation needs to be explored again. The BL requires translation of life skill to research skills, self-learning, self engagement and computer literacy

- It is the responsibility of the participant to take a NOC or inform their employer.
